

Data protection information for event participants

In the present notice, we would like to explain how your personal data will be processed when you visit one of our events.

1. Who is responsible for processing your data, and how can you reach the Data Protection Officer?

2. Which data categories do we use and where do they originate from?

We process your contact data. Your personal data will be collected directly from you when you register for our event. During the event, photographs and videos may be taken in which you could be identified.

3. For what purposes and on what legal basis is your data processed?

We need your contact data for the management of the event. The legal basis for the processing of data for events is Article 6 para. 1 lit. f) GDPR (legitimate interest, namely communication with contractual and business partners) if you are a contractual or business partner or you are our contact person at a contractual or business partner, otherwise your consent acc. to Art. 6 para. 1 lit a) GDPR. If you have registered for an event, the legal bases is Article 6 para. 1 lit. b) GDPR (contract for the organisation of the event).

We may take photographs/videos of you at our event to document the event and to use the resulting photographs/videos for press and public relations purposes. The legal basis for taking photographs/videos is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f) GDPR (legitimate interest in documenting the events we offer and our legitimate interest in presenting Munich Re Investment GmbH partners through press and public relations work).

If we intend to process photographs/videos of you in which you are clearly recognisable/highlighted and that we take for the purpose of press and public relations work or for the creation of advertising

materials, we will ask for your prior consent. In this case, the legal basis is your consent acc. to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a) GDPR.

4. Who receives your data?

Contact data may be transmitted to service providers and business partners, if this is necessary for the organisation of the event. The photographs/videos taken may be transmitted to journalists and media companies, also abroad, for the purpose of press and public relations work and may be published by us. We use service providers by way of processing on behalf, in particular for the provision and maintenance of IT systems.

5. How long will your data be stored?

All accounting-relevant data is stored in accordance with tax and commercial law retention obligations. These include, in particular, the German Commercial Code (HGB) and the German Fiscal Code (AO). The retention and documentation periods specified there are up to ten years. Archived photographs/videos of the event and publications are generally not deleted.

6. What privacy rights can you claim as a data subject?

You may request information on the stored data about you from the address indicated above. In addition, under certain conditions you may request that your data be deleted or corrected. Furthermore, you may also have a right to restrict the processing of your data and a right to disclosure of the data you have made available in a structured, common and machine-readable format. If we process your data for the purpose of safeguarding legitimate interests according to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f) GDPR, you may object to this processing to the above address if your particular situation gives grounds for objecting to this data processing. We will then stop that processing, unless it serves our overriding, compelling legitimate interests or the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

7. Would you like to complain about how your data is handled?

8. Are you obliged to provide your personal data?

We need your contact details in order to plan our events. Invitations cannot be sent and participation in events is not possible without the provision of basic data.

If you do not wish to be photographed/filmed, please let us know in advance by e-mail or directly at the event (objection within the meaning of Art. 21 GDPR). Your refusal to be photographed/filmed does not preclude your participation in our events.

If you consented to us taking photos/videos of you in which you are highlighted/clearly recognizable, you may revoke such consent at any time without providing reason and without affecting your rights. Any processing done before the revocation would remain valid, however. If you revoke your consent for photos/videos already taken, or for them to be used, Munich Re Investment Partners will delete and/or block them. Your revocation does not preclude your participation in our events.
